## Experience the Castles and Gardens of Europe

### Prague to Cologne



- Day 1**  
**6/27/12** **Depart U.S. home gateway airport to Prague**
- Day 2**  
**6/28/12** **Prague**  
Be greeted by a Uniworld representative and transfer to the Imperial Hotel. Check in and enjoy the rest of your day at leisure.
- Day 3**  
**6/29/12** **Prague**  
**Featured excursion: Prague city tour**  
Beauty and drama abound in the "City of Spires." You'll see a fairy-tale city with Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Art Nouveau styles, passing places like the State Opera House, Wenceslas Square, and the Charles Bridge, before finishing up in Old Town - a UNESCO World Heritage Site. BB, D
- Day 4**  
**6/30/12** **Prague**  
**Featured excursion: Jewish Prague**  
Explore Jewish Prague on a walking tour of Josefov, the city's old Jewish quarter, including Europe's oldest surviving Jewish cemetery; Old New Synagogue, Europe's oldest active synagogue; and Pinkas Synagogue, now a memorial to Holocaust victims. BB
- Day 5**  
**7/1/12** **Prague to Nuremberg and ship**  
Travel by motor coach approximately three hours from Prague to Nuremberg, where you will board *River Ambassador*. BB, D
- Day 6**  
**7/2/12** **Nuremberg**  
**Featured excursion: Choice of City tour and Hesperides Gardens or WWII historical tour**  
A panoramic tour will highlight Kaiserburg Castle and this archetypal Medieval German city - encircled by defensive walls and red-roofed buildings. After your city tour, you will visit Nuremberg's historic Hesperides Gardens, which boast Italian-style plantings. Or turn back the pages of history with a guided tour of the city's most important WWII sites, including the newly opened Nuremberg Trials Memoriam. BB, L, D - [Captain's Welcome Gala](#)
- Day 7**  
**7/3/12** **Hassfurt (Bamberg-a UNESCO World Heritage City)**  
**Featured excursion: Bamberg city tour**  
Bamberg has one of Europe's largest intact Old Town centers. Your morning walking tour takes you past the Imperial Cathedral, Town Hall, and "Little Venice," an area of colorful 19th-century fishermen's houses. You'll also visit the four-winged New Residence - the ornate former home of Bamberg's prince-bishops - and get a panoramic view of the city from the lovely rose gardens. BB, L, D
- Day 8**  
**7/4/12** **Würzburg**  
**Featured excursion: Würzburg Residenz visit and choice of wine tasting or walking tour**  
Würzburg Residence - an immaculate example of Baroque architecture - is a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site. It features the largest ceiling fresco in the world and some of the most expansive gardens in Europe. Your estate tour will be capped off by a private wine tasting of Franconian wines in the historic cellars. Or tour the city, one of the loveliest in Germany. BB, L, D
- Day 9**  
**7/5/12** **Miltenberg, cruising the Main River, Aschaffenburg**  
**Featured excursion: Walking tour and Schloss Kleinheubach**  
On your walking tour, you'll see fairy-tale-like 14th- and 15th-century half-timbered houses. Then you visit the magnificent Schloss Kleinheubach castle, where you will enjoy a tour by a member of the Princely family - a Uniworld exclusive - and reception featuring wine from the house of Lowenstein-Wertheim-Rosenberg. In the late afternoon, you sail along the Main. BB, L, D
- Day 10**  
**7/6/12** **Aschaffenburg, cruising the Main River, Frankfurt**  
**Featured excursion: Walking tour and Johannisburg Castle**  
You dock at what is considered the "Bavarian Nice" for its mild climate and Mediterranean gardens and visit the Pomejanum - a perfect replica of a Roman house - next to the grand Renaissance Johannisburg castle. Then enjoy scenic sailing along the Main. BB, L, D
- Day 11**  
**7/7/12** **Cruising the Rhine to Koblenz**  
**Featured excursion: Walking tour and Ehrenbreitstein Fortress**  
In the morning, you sail through the Upper Middle Rhine Valley to Koblenz, where you wind your way through narrow streets and historic squares, taking in Old Town and the 12th-century Church of Our Lady. Then you'll take a breathtaking trip across the Rhine on an aerial cable car to the fortress of Ehrenbreitstein. BB, L, D - [Captain's Farewell Dinner](#)

**7/8/12** **Cologne**  
**Featured excursion: Cologne walking tour**  
You are transferred from the ship to your hotel in Cologne before taking a walking tour of the city, including the magnificent Cologne Cathedral, with the largest façade of any church in the world, and the Roman Museum. BB,D - [AAA's Farewell Dinner](#)

**7/9/12** **Cologne, transfer to Düsseldorf airport for flight home**
